Admission Instructions, Requirements, and Procedures

Priority Application Deadlines:

For students **NOT** currently living or studying in the United States and applying from another country:
July 1 for the August (Fall) term | November 1 for the January (Spring) term

Applications received after these priority deadlines will be processed. However, we cannot guarantee that adequate time will allow for visa processing and travel plans in time for the term start.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

An application for admission, completed, signed, scanned, and emailed to global@tomkinscortland.edu or sent via postal mail to the address above.

Your TOEFL or IELTS score

If you are already in the United States at the time of application, you may substitute the Accuplacer test.

If you have already taken the equivalent of college-level Freshman English composition course at a U.S. or Canadian institution, the test score requirement may be waived.

Upon arrival, you will be required to undergo English and Math placement testing unless you are exempted through transfer credits. If you place into ESL courses, you will be required to complete those prior to enrolling in other academic courses.

Transcripts from all high schools, universities, and/or colleges attended.

Certified translations of each transcript must be provided for transcripts not in English.

In order to be considered for transfer credit for your degree program, official, original transcripts must be sent directly from the other U.S. college or university via postal mail to:

A signed Affidavit of Support from your sponsor

A bank statement from your sponsor showing a minimum balance of \$20,010 if you will live on campus and reserve your campus housing prior to the deadline, \$25,460 if you will live off campus.

If you have been awarded a government or other scholarship you may substitute documentation of the scholarship for the affidavit of support and bank statement, as long as it shows sufficient resources to cover all of your costs.

A copy of your current passport identification page.

When your application is received, you will receive an email with information about how to pay the \$50 application fee, which will help to cover the cost of shipping your I-20 and other admission documents to you via courier service. You cannot be fully admitted until the application fee is paid.
