Submission Guidelines

- Submissions should show the results of research, reflection, and creative thinking. Methods and format will vary from discipline to discipline. For example, a science paper may include a lab report. Appropriate submissions include research papers, essays, personal essays, book and article reviews, full-text speeches, technical reports, creative nonfiction, and other responses to academic assignments.
- Any writing completed for Tompkins Cortland CC courses during the Spring 2017, Fall 2017, or Spring 2018 semesters is eligible.
- Submissions are limited to two entries per student.
- Papers submitted for previous Tompkins Cortland CC Student Writing Showcase competitions may not be resubmitted. Students, however, are encouraged to enter the competition again with new material.
- Submission length may not exceed 5000 words (approximately 20 typewritten, double-spaced pages).
- This **Cover Sheet** (completed by student) plus a title page with **title only** must be attached to the submission. The **name of the student must not appear** anywhere in the submission other than on the Student Writing Showcase Cover Sheet.

- Papers may be submitted **now through Noon on April 16, 2018.**
